## Popsicle Stick Paper Lantern Craft

What you will need:

- Popsicle sticks x 16
- Plain white paper
- Coloured markers, textas, pencils etc.
- Craft glue or hot glue
- Optional: LED tealight (available from Kmart in a pack of 6)

### Instructions:

1. Glue four craft sticks together to make a square; this will make up one side of your lantern. Make three more squares like the first one.
2. Cut 4 pieces of paper big enough to cover your craft stick squares.
3. Time to decorate your lantern! You might like to:
  - a. Write a short line from the passage
    - i. Let your light shine
    - ii. You are the light of the world
  - b. Write out one of the verses
    - i. "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."  
– Matthew 5:16
  - c. Draw something that gives off light. Examples:
    - i. Lantern
    - ii. Torch
    - iii. Candle
    - iv. The sun
    - v. Stars
4. When you have finished decorating, glue your lantern panels to the craft stick squares.
5. Glue your four craft stick squares together.
6. Optional: Place an LED tealight candle inside to make your lantern light up.
