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Family Activity

P-Year 2

Leaves and Grapes

Provide each family member with a piece of paper and let them draw the trunk and bare branches of a tree using a brown marker.

Provide each family member with green paint

Dip hands into green finger paint to create the leaves of the tree.

After the hand prints are dry, they can dip the tips of their fingers in blue finger paint to create clusters of grapes.

When all is finished, write, JESUS IS THE TRUE VINE AND WE ARE THE BRANCHES at the base of the tree.

Ask each family member to draw/write a sentence about something they have learnt about Jesus

Year 3-6

Vine Line

Provide each family member with a sheet of white or light-colored construction paper and have them draw a long curvy line around their paper using a brown marker to represent a vine.

Provide each family member with green paper, draw and cut out small pieces of green paper in the shape of leaves and glue them at several places along the vine.

Use your finger tips dipped into purple finger paint to make clusters of grapes.

When your picture is finished, write, Jesus said, "I am the true vine." at the bottom.
